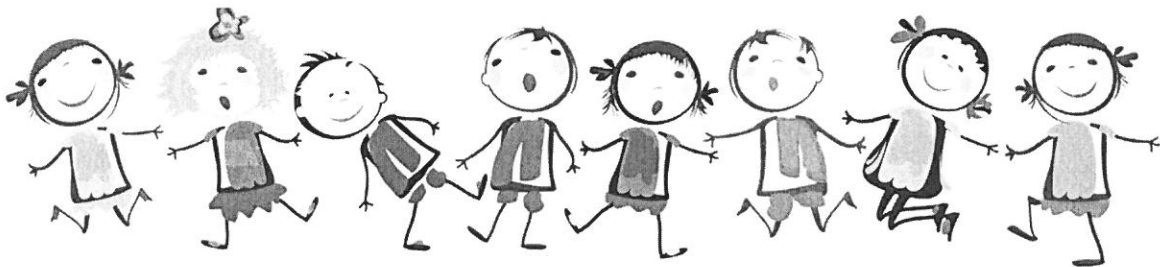

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Reading

Nightly Reading

Your child will bring home a reading envelope each night with at least one book. Continue to read and reread these books until new ones are sent home. Please enjoy other books that you have at home or check out from the library as well.

Year Long 40 Book Challenge

Students are given a 40 book challenge for the school year. If your child is **reading at least 80 minutes each week**, he/she should be successful at meeting this goal. A log will be included in their reading envelope in order to track the amount of books read.

Incomplete Math Journals

Your child will bring his/her math journal home if they weren't able to complete the work in class. It should be completed and returned the very next day.
